Reservation Booking Policy

Pre-Season Reservations (Prior to May 15th)

- Book reservations immediately upon joining Olson's Classic Yachts.
- Up to five different preseason reservations may be booked.
- · A single reservation may include as many contiguous half day/full day sail slots as desired.

In-Season Reservations

- All bookings must be made at least 36 hours prior to the scheduled sail time.
- Free spontaneous reservations apply to weekday slots not otherwise scheduled three days in advance.

Booking Procedure

- All bookings are made via email with confirmations posted daily on the scheduling calendar.
- All slot assignments are assigned to the first email reservation received.
